Visa contact for the Philippines?

- Request for Carla to find a person to write Visa letters for those who need them from a person in the Philippines
- Do not need a Visa
Nationals from the following countries are allowed to enter the Philippines without a visa for a period of stay of thirty (30) days or less:
 - Australia
 - Canada
 - Indonesia
 - Qatar
 - South Korea
 - Saudi Arabia
 - United Arab Emirates
 - United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland
 - USA
 - Vietnam
- The following are allowed to enter the Philippines without a visa for a stay not exceeding fourteen (14) days:
 - Hong Kong
 - Macau
- Need a Visa
Holders of passports issued by any country except the following may obtain a visa (for a fee) valid for 59 days on arrival:
 - China
 - India
 - Pakistan
 - Taiwan
