- Request for Carla to find a person to write Visa letters for those who need them from a person in the Philippines
- Do not need a Visa

Nationals from the following countries are allowed to enter the Philippines <u>without a visa for a</u> period of stay of thirty (30) days or less:

- o Australia
- o Canada
- o Indonesia
- o Qatar
- South Korea

- o United Arab Emirates
- United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland
- o USA
- o Vietnam

- o Saudi Arabia
- The following are allowed to enter the Philippines <u>without a visa for a stay not exceeding</u> <u>fourteen (14) days</u>:
  - o Hong Kong
  - o Macau
- Need a Visa

Holders of passports issued by any country except the following may obtain a visa (for a fee) valid for 59 days on arrival:

- o China
- o India
- o Pakistan
- o Taiwan
