Meeting was called to order at 10PM

President's Message (Sing Chee)

- Good morning. Thanking staff for setting up the Virtual Conference
- We are having Career Construction seminar in Singapore and it will give a chance to announce APCDA Conference
- PCDA members get the Member rate at the APCDA Conference in return for marketing our conference to PCDA members (and other associations can request this arrangement also)
- Looking forward to new initiatives this year

Treasurer's Report - Please see the attached Balance Sheets and Budget and Profit & Loss Sheet

- Our Assets continue to grow.
- Expenses exceeded income so far, but this will change in January because the Conference Registration is now open.
- The funds donated in the prior fiscal year for Staff Development are showing as over-budget expenses in the current fiscal year. This is misleading because the funds are not part of our normal budget and were intended to be spent immediately, but it took a few months to disperse them. Marilyn will consult with our accountant on how to show them more accurately.

Journal Report

 We are in between our successful publication of the September issue and the upcoming March issue. The new Editorial Assistant Hongshan Shao is proving to be a valuable contributor to our process. The journal podcast will be airing an episode once per month this year beginning in January. Brian Hutchison, Editor (excused)

Discussion Topics:

- Martha Russell Endowment Interest funds: how do we plan to spend them:
 - The Martha Russell Endowment instructs us to spend the interest every year. Of
 course, these are exceptional times. But we do have extra interest which "should" be
 spent, and the donor asked that we consider spending funds on career services training
 events in not-high income countries.
 - Many of our leaders have been providing webinars pro-bono. Currently, all events fall

- in the "webinar" category during the pandemic. But we could consider providing an honorarium for those providing training for a not high-income country. Maybe we should advertise this option.
- Connie: think that the pro-bono webinars were intended as service to our profession, did not expect being paid for it.
- Allan: It might be nice to offer an honorarium at the end of year for several donations.
 If we ask an individual to provide a training program, then we should pay that person.
 Are we under the pressure to spend all the interest earn? (The only "rule" is that the interest should not accumulate over time. But in these exceptional times, we could decide to wait for the new normal.)
- Satomi: Define a structure/framework for spending the funds (number of trainings, people, etc.) At the beginning of the year, we should decide what can be accomplished based on the available funds.
- (Agreed)Establish sub-committee to work out the details: Satomi, Allan, Gulnur

Member meeting topic and discussions for May 19, 2021:

- Allan: pulling out topics from the survey (what are emerging issues for us, that we want membership input?) Leadership should shape the discussions and also take a lead on selecting the webinar topics.
- What are the most important issues in your country and how can APCDA help you to cope with them?
- Sing Chee: Implementation of our 4th mission item. How can we make people more committed to career services?
- What activities could APCDA offer that would be more engaging for you?
- Agnes: show examples of commitment from those we have been serving for a while at APCDA.
- We have to ensure that our webinars are used appropriately and are not used for commercial purposes.
