President's Message (Momoko)

Report on Engagement Research Project (Serene)

- Our membership numbers have stagnated.
- Restarted literature review.
- Committee members need to read the literature review articles.
- Serene is adding articles from journals.
- We have an eager group who wants to work on this.

Discussion Topic: Marketing offer by BIG

- When companies that seem unrelated to us ask for us to work with them, what do we do?
 - Blockchain Industry Group (BIG) wants to “partner” with us for marketing our conference
 - They have 6.4 million people on their website
 - They listed our event under “Jobs and Careers” – very nice to be listed
- Another offer by a marketing firm would charge us \$2000 to redo our marketing so we could convert more visitors to members.
 - We work on a very tight budget because more than half of our member countries are Not High income
- Most associations post only their own events – most do not co-market
- Our pathway to convert students to member is via our scholarship program. The vast majority of students drop their membership after one free year.
 - We could work harder to reach universities in all parts of the world.
 - That could be a Membership Committee project or a Scholarship Committee project.
 - Could APCDA become a CICA affiliated program? Serene & Felicity could work on that
- Recommendations of Officers:
 - We should talk with BIG and see how we can work together

- We need to find organizations that relate to our goals. Are these groups relevant to us? BIG's members would probably not relate to our conference.
- We have not budgeted for marketing. We need to make this a regular part of our budget
- Perhaps we can focus on membership engagement and develop a marketing plan based on those issues.
