Treasurer's Report (see attached financial statements)

- Gift from Drs. David Reile & Barbara Suddarth
 - o Gift amount \$15,000
 - Purpose: to pay The Gender Lab to conduct 2 webinars and design instructional materials for us. Amount to be paid to The Gender Lab: \$12,000 (\$3000 is income for us)
 - We will pay Gender Lab \$3000 a month for the next 3 months. At this time, our checking account still holds \$9000 owed to GenderLab, so we will need to dip into savings to pay our bills very soon.
- Comments
 - Looking at the income and expenses, the conference appears to have earned \$3576 net income, but we licensed Whova in FY22 for \$4450. Also, we have not yet transferred the \$5000 from savings to conference income for scholarships, so this will improve the conference net income.
 - Although this conference was not a financial success, it supported a part of our region and we are proud to have supported APCDA's mission in this way.
 - Appreciate the leadership and restraint in fiscal management.

Report on APCDA Software Infrastructure (Marilyn)

- Wild Apricot is outdated and they just raised the fees. It would take an inconceivable amount of work to convert to a new database, but perhaps it is time. We are looking at alternatives.
- Cost of Wild Apricot: \$3780 last year, for next year \$4752 (August)
- Cost of Tradewing: \$3000
- One new option: Growthzone: \$3576 annual, \$2999 onboarding


Discussion Topic: What does APCDA offer in comparison to other international associations?
