Participants may submit an abstract(s) with a maximum of 250 words. The abstract may be submitted by sending an email to ccldsgt2024@gmail.com. Abstract must be written in English only in text format in MS Word, Font=Times New Roman 12, and 1.5 line spacing. Do not include any graphs, tables or images. Name of the presenting author should be underlined. The title of the abstract should be BOLD and font size 14 and Author affiliation in font size 10. Abstract must be submitted using the designated field: Introduction, Methodology, Results, Discussion, Conclusion. Abstract should contain work that is original and has not been previously published.

The submission should be carefully proofread and corrected by the author. Individual authors are responsible for the accuracy of the information supplied, as accepted abstracts will be printed or showcased in the conference publication materials. Selected papers presented in the conference will be published as international conference proceedings.

All abstracts will be reviewed by the scientific committee. Only those abstracts adjudged of high quality and of relevance will be accepted. Acceptance notification will be sent to the first submitting author and presenter with further instructions.

Registration is compulsory for attending and presenting paper and inclusion of abstracts/full length papers in proceedings.

He has co-authored a Certified Career Services Provider (CCSP)-eligible curriculum (entitled the International Career Coach curriculum) for Mindler. In his partnership with Mindler, he has helped trained hundreds of credentialed career services providers in India and the UAE. He is a Fellow of NCDA and remains an active member of the NCDA ethics committee. He received the Lifetime Achievement award from the Asia Pacific Career Development Association in 2023.

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


