Treasure's Report (see attached financial reports)

- Strong financial situation
- Current liabilities toward expenses payable to Dr. Marilyn Maze will be made on maturity of the CD's in mid October.
- The new website and data management software ongoing costs will be similar to the former cost of Wild Apricot (before they raised their fees). Setup expenses are about \$3000 total and will be incurred now (either this fiscal year or at the start of next fiscal year). However, the new data management system billing is monthly (instead of paying for a year upfront), so we will not see a sudden increase in expenses.
- Marilyn finds ways not to spend money.
- We put our money and energy into serving members and providing Free or inexpensive learning.

Discussion: MOU with Syed Iqbal

- This situation is similar to others we have faced many times in the past
 - o Similar to cooperation with other non-profits
 - We have ongoing MOUs with many associations (NCDA, CERIC, CDAA, etc.)
 - Similar to our sponsors and advertisers We charge advertisers for similar services:
 - Articles in our news blog,
 - Introductions to our members who might be interested in working with them
 - Display booths at our conferences
 - We have an advertising fee schedule (attached)
- Scope of program
 - APCDA members may provide services which:
 - Enable individuals to learn how to make informed and relevant career choices based upon self-discovery and opportunity analysis and execution strategies;

- Support individuals in assisting them in developing a career plan which may include skills development and training requirements;
- Support individuals with desired job applications and job-securing strategies;
- Support individuals and their families in their transition to work;
- Assist individuals in enhancing their local professional career development practice and network.
- Provide research to support the development of career development practices and in participating countries; or
- Provide consultancy, coaching and counseling services to enhance career development practices across the region.
- Employment Agency will establish an independent international focused employment agency whose responsibilities will include:
 - Daily operations of employment services including marketing, sales, and service delivery;
 - Coordinating services to participating organizations, countries and individuals seeking better career opportunities;
 - Coordinating migration services necessary for international travel; and
 - Negotiating with regional authorities about employment and work permit requirements.
- Areas of cooperation
 - Employment Agency agrees to assure that clients are provided career planning assistance that is consistent with the mission of APCDA.
 - APCDA agrees to inform its members, and people and agencies involved in the employment services community in member countries of the projects of Employment Agency and APCDA's support for the mission.
 - APCDA will assist Employment Agency by informing its members of opportunities to provide career development services to clients of Employment Agency.
- Comments:
 - Officers accepted the similarity of the MOU with the existing advertiser guidelines
 - Some of the observations made by the officers include:
 - This version is much clearer and carefully written
 - See this as an opportunity to spread our ethics and values across the region.
 - By Introducing the Employment Agency on the website, we would ensure no ambiguity in the role of APCDA in the minds of the members.
