- We normally drop about \$4000 between October 1 and January 1 when the conference registration opens.
- If our checking account is unexpected depleted, we can take money from our 1-year CD by forfeiting the interest earned since October (which is a very small penalty).
- Our Checking account earns no interest, so losing interest earned on money we need is not a big concern.
- The Board unanimously chose Option 2

FY23 Budget (See attached)

- As usual, the budget for the conference is very conservative (low attendance projection, all expenses covered with this scenario)
- A hybrid conference with a combination of online and in-person is a good one.
- This budget gives us a target. We are better at promoting and explaining value now, so it is likely we will exceed our target.


