- Arun shared his work on designing certificates and a logo for the accreditation seal.
- Marilyn expressed concerns about accrediting unreliable organizations, emphasizing the need to proceed cautiously to avoid damaging their reputation.
- All accredited programs will be listed on the APCDA website to assure that schools cannot claim accreditation if they don't have it.
- accreditation fees for postgraduate programs in Australia can reach \$15,000 and involve auditors' costs. Our fees are lower because we conduct remote audits using volunteers, but volunteers may get overworked. The fees aim to cover APCDA's operational costs while providing affordable accreditation.
- Board to further discuss raising LOEP accreditation fees at next meeting.

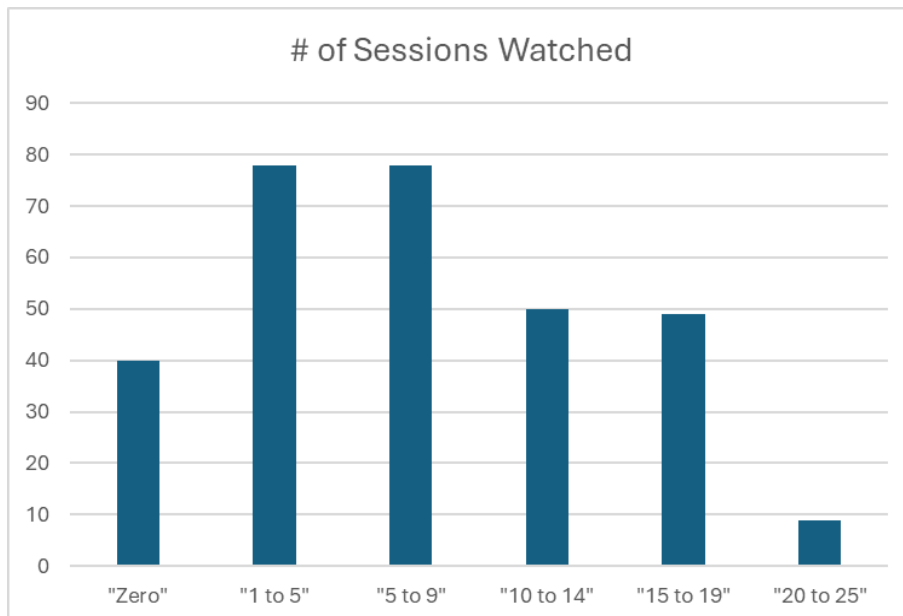

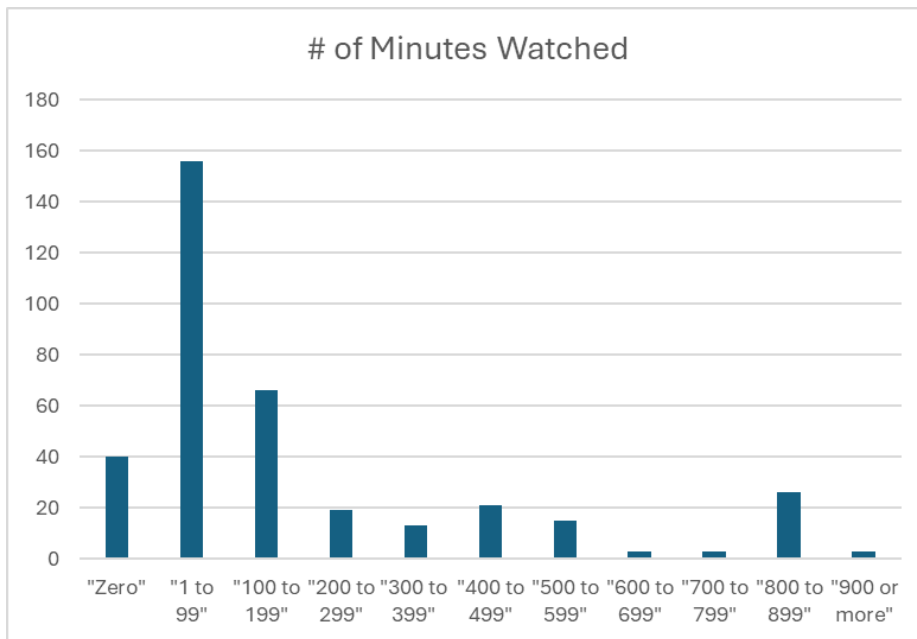
